Rules and Regulations, Grand Chapter of Virginia, O.E.S.

Pages 40-41 (2010) - Section 43. Suspension for Nonpayment of Dues. Any member of a Chapter who is in arrears for one (1) year is delinquent and may be suspended from membership. At some stated meeting during the year the Secretary shall read in open Chapter the names of all members who are delinquent and record same in the minutes, after which notice shall be given each delinquent to appear at a stated meeting and show cause why she/he should not be suspended. The payment of the dues will be a sufficient response.

If the delinquent fails to appear, or appearing, fails to show good cause for such delinquency, she/he may be suspended by a majority vote of the members present. The Chapter may in its discretion remit all or part of the dues of any delinquent or extend the time of payment of same; provided that when a member owes twenty-four (24) months dues, she/he is automatically suspended.

No Chapter shall continue a member more than twenty-four months (24) unless the dues be paid or remitted.
